



Priority Status for 2012 Standard Eligibility Tournaments

The following priority with regards to a members playing status will be used to fill all Standard Eligibility Tournament fields:

1. Top 80: Top 80 on the LPGA Official Money List at the end of the last official LPGA tournament of the previous year, with priority based on the order of the list.

2. Career Top 20: Top 20 on the LPGA career money list as of the end of the last official LPGA tournament of the previous year, with priority based on the order of the list, provided that: (a) the player must have competed in at least ten (10) official LPGA tournaments during the previous two years, (b) the player must notify the LPGA that she wants to be included in the Career Top 20 Category by December 15 of the previous year, (c) if a player elects to be included in the Career Top 20 Category, she will be in this Category for one year, (d) a player may be included in this category only two times in her career, and (e) a player may only be in the Career Top 20 Category or the Career Top 40 Category (but not both) in her career (and being in the Career Top 20 and Career Top 40 categories in years prior to 2009 counts against this one-time allowance).

3. Major Winner: Winners of LPGA major championships during the previous five (5) years, with priority based on the number of such wins during the previous five (5) years (and any ties broken by the players' positions on the LPGA career money list as of the end of the previous year). To be eligible for this category, a player must have played in at least ten (10) official LPGA tournaments during the previous two (2) years.

4. Multiple Wins: Winners of at least two (2) official LPGA tournaments during the previous four (4) years, with priority based on the number of wins in official LPGA tournaments during the previous four (4) years (any ties broken by the players' positions on the LPGA career money list as of the end of the previous year). To be eligible for this category, a player must have played in at least ten (10) official LPGA tournaments during the previous two (2) years.

5. Current Year Win: Winners of official LPGA tournaments during the current year, with priority based on the earliest date of such wins, provided that any non-LPGA member winner must have joined the LPGA in order to be placed in this category.

5(a) Three Wins in the Same Season: For the 2012 LPGA season, winners of three(3) or more official LPGA tournaments during the same calendar year from 2007-2011; and for the 2013 LPGA season, winners of three (3) or more official LPGA tournaments during the same calendar year from 2008-2012; in each case with priority based on the number of wins during any calendar year (and with any ties broken by the players' positions on the LPGA career money list as of the end of the previous year).

6. One Win: For the 2012 LPGA season and thereafter, winners of one official LPGA tournament during the previous two years, with priority based on the number of wins in official LPGA tournaments during the previous two years (and any ties broken by the players' positions on the LPGA Career Earnings List as of the end of the previous year).

7. Non-Member Win: Winners of at least one (1) official LPGA official tournament during the previous calendar year while not an LPGA member, with priority based on the earliest date of such wins.

8. Current Year Top 40: Players in the top 40 on the current year's LPGA Official Money List after the 8th official LPGA tournament of the year (Mobile Bay LPGA Classic) with priority based on the order of the list. For the remaining official LPGA tournaments of the year, players in the Top 40 on the current year's LPGA Official Money List after the 14th official LPGA tournament of the year (U.S. Women's Open), with priority based on the order of the list.

9. Top 5 LPGA Symetra Tour: Top 5 on the previous year's LPGA FUTURES Tour Official Money List, with priority based on the position on the list.

10. Non-Member Top 80: Each player who, as of the conclusion of the last official LPGA tournament of the previous year, won an amount of money as a non-LPGA member during such year in official LPGA co-sponsored domestic tournaments with field of seventy-five (75) or more, that is equal to or greater than the amount of official money won by the player who was in th 80 place on the LPGA Official Money List at that time (with priority based on the amount of money won in such tournaments).

11. Top 20 Q-School Category/Nos. 81-100: In alternating order, Top 20 from the previous year's LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament and Nos. 81-100 on the LPGA Official Money List at the end of the last official LPGA tournament of the previous year, with (in the case of the Qualifying Tournament players) any ties broken on the basis of the lowest most recent round in th the final and sectional Qualifying Tournament, except that, in the event of a tie for 20th place at the Qualifying Tournament, the 20th place shall be determined through a play-off held at the Qualifying Tournament.

Alternating order starts with the top finisher at the Qualifying Tournament, then goes to the 81st player on the LPGA Official Money List, then goes to the 2nd place finisher at the Qualifying Tournament, then goes to the 82nd player on the LPGA Official Money List, etc. However, if a player No. 81-100 on the LPGA Official Money List at the end of the last official LPGA tournament of the previous year, improves her status within this category by way of her finish in the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, she will assume the higher priority status. Her lower priority status will be assumed by the next available player within this category from the LPGA Official Money List of the previous year who has also not improved her status via the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament.

Example: A player finishes 95th on the LPGA Official Money List at the end of the last official LPGA tournament of the previous year. She competes in the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament and finishes 1st. She assumes the higher priority status within this category and vacates her lower priority status position, which is then assumed by the player who finishes 96th on the LPGA Money List of the previous year. If the player who finishes 96th on the LPGA Official Money List also improves her position within this category via the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, the player who finished 97th on the LPGA Official Money List will assume the vacated priority status by the who finished 95th and the player who finished 98th will assume the priority status vacated by the player who finished 96th etc.

12. Top 40 Two Years Prior: Top 40 on the LPGA Official Money List at the end of the last official LPGA tournaments of two (2) years previous, with priority based on the order of the list. To be eligible for this category, a player must have played in at least ten (10) official LPGA tournaments during the previous two years.

13. Three-Time Futures Current-Year Win Category: Winners of three (3) official LPGA Futures Tour tournaments during the current year. (A person does not gain LPGA membership by winning three times on the Futures Tour. If the person entering through this category is not an LPGA member, any prize money she wins will be unofficial for purposes of the LPGA Official Money List, although if she wins the tournament it will be considered an official LPGA win. If the person entering through this category is an LPGA member, prize money she wins will be considered official.)

14. Career Top 40: Top 40 on the LPGA career earnings list as of the end of the previous year, with priority based on the order of the list, provided that: (a) the player must have competed in at least ten (10) official LPGA tournaments during the previous two (2) years, (b) the player must notify the LPGA that she wants to be included in the Career Top 40 Category by December 15 of the previous year, and (c) if a player elects to be included in the Career Top 40 Category she will be in this category for one year, (d) a player may be included in this category only one time in her career, (e) a player may only be in the Career Top 40 Category or the Career Top 20 Category (but not both) in her career (and being in the Career Top 20 and Career Top 40 categories in years prior to 2009 counts against this one-time allowance).

Teaching & Club Professional Entries: The Champion of the most recent LPGA Teaching and Club Professional (T&CP) National Championship and the Champion of the most recent T&CP Section Championship of each T&CP Section may enter one (1) standard eligibility event during her tenure as Champion, falling in priority behind Category 20, with priority among the T&CP members going first to the National Champion, and then to the Section Champion whose Section residence is closest to the event.

Medical, Maternity and Family Leave Extensions:

For 2012, players with medical, maternity and family leave extensions of status will slot in the priority list category that most closely approximate their status at the beginning of 2011.

Re-Shuffle: After the 8th official LPGA Tour event (Mobile Bay LPGA Classic) players in categories 15 through 22 will be re-ordered with priority based on the order of the current year's LPGA Official Money List, falling in priority behind Category 14.

After the 14th official LPGA Tour event (U.S. Women's Open) players in categories 15 through 22 will be re-ordered with priority based on the order of the current year's LPGA Official Money List, falling in priority behind Category 14.

Special Entries:

Places will be reserved in tournaments with standard eligibility fields, as follows:

1. Hall of Fame/Tournament Winners Entries: Two places will be reserved for LPGA Tour Hall of Fame members not otherwise eligible, with priority based on the number of official LPGA tournament wins as of the end of the previous year (and any ties broken by the players' positions on the LPGA career earnings list as of the end of the previous year). Any such places not used by Hall of Fame members will be reserved for winners of eight (8) or more official LPGA tournaments held within the previous twenty (20) years who are not otherwise eligible, with priority based on the number of wins (and any ties broken by the players' position on the LPGA career money list as of the end of the previous year). Note: When calculating the number of wins for this purpose, a win of any LPGA Major Championship shall be counted as two (2) wins, and the member may enter no more than two (2) tournaments a year through this entry criteria.

2. Sponsor Invitations: Two (2) places will be reserved for sponsor invitations (in special circumstances necessitated by a tournament location outside the United States or a sponsor from another country, a limited number of additional sponsor invitations may be made available).

3. Local Qualifying: Two (2) places will be reserved for players competing in the open qualifying round.

4. Late Entries: Two (2) places will be reserved for the following players who have not committed to the tournament by the commitment deadline: (a) the winner of the immediately preceding week's official LPGA tournament and (b) Hall of Fame members, provided that (i) such player notifies an LPGA Tournament Official at the site of the immediately preceding tournament of her intention to enter no later than one (1) after the conclusion of such immediately preceding tournament and (ii) a player may not enter this way more than once a year. Priority will first be given to the winner of the immediately preceding week's tournament, and then to Hall of Fame members based on the number of official LPGA tournament wins as of the end of the previous year (and any ties broken by the players' positions on the LPGA career earnings list as of the end of the previous year).

5. Previous Week Top 10: Two (2) places will be reserved for players who are not otherwise eligible, as follows: Each of the top two (2) of such players who finish in the Top 10 in a standard eligibility LPGA tournament prior to the final standard eligibility tournament of the year (a "Top 10 Event") are entitled to places in the next standard-eligibility tournament after the Top 10 Event, with any tie for the second such player broken by according the place of the player with the lowest most recent round in the Top 10 Event or other official LPGA tournament. If the LPGA tournament immediately following the Top 10 Event is not a standard eligibility event, the players shall be entitled to places in the next standard-eligibility tournament after that.
